Ambitions

- ▶ All the partners have the ambition to become the national competence centre on social innovation
- ▶ The way to reach this goal will be different because there is no “one size fits all” way to do this. So each country has its own challenges. Some examples:
 - Creation of a space to experiment
 - Enabling further investment in promising innovations
 - Transcending policy silos
 - Capacity building
 - Motivating cooperation
 - Stimulate social innovation in public bodies
